

LAKES OF THE FOUR SEASONS DECAL PLACEMENT RULES

Residents of Lakes of the Four Seasons need to be aware that to use any motorized vehicle within our community, the following rules must be followed:

- ❑ You **MUST** have a valid drivers license.
- ❑ You **MUST** have a current POA decal to enter all gates, except the main gate.
- ❑ Only the **CURRENT** POA decal is allowed to be on a vehicle at any one time. All others **MUST** be removed. LOFS decals **MUST** be removed when the vehicle is sold.
- ❑ You may use LOFS streets in a properly licensed car, truck or motorcycle without a POA decal, but you **MUST** use the main gate to enter or leave.

You can obtain the proper POA decal for you vehicle by taking your registration to the POA office and paying the required fee. You must **NOT** have a balance over 30 days old to receive the proper decal. Placement of the current POA decals requires that they be permanently affixed to the locations described below. Anywhere else is a violation resulting in a fine of \$50.00.

Cars and Trucks: Permanently affixed to the left (driver's) side rear window or the left lower corner of the windshield.

Snowmobiles: Affixed to the lower left side of the windshield.

Golf Carts:

- ❑ **POA decal:** Affixed to the right rear bumper. If there is not a right rear bumper, then visible to anybody behind the golf cart.
- ❑ **Golf Cart Trail Fee Decal:** Affixed to the right front bumper. If no bumper on the right front, visible to anyone in front of the golf cart.

BOATS

- ❑ **POA decal:** Affixed on the rear and to the right (starboard) side, above the waterline.
- ❑ **Rental Dock Decal:** Affixed directly adjacent to the current POA decal.

PERSONAL WATERCRAFT: affixed on the front and to the right (starboard) side, above the waterline.

BOAT TRAILER: Affixed on the right side of the trailer near the winch.

MOTORCYCLES: affixed to the left side, visible to anyone on the left while the motorcycle is being driven.
