

SERVICES AND COLLECTION DATES FOR THE 2019 SEASON

Leaf Collections for the entire community

Spring Leaf collections will begin April 8th and continue until the final date of April 22nd

No collections after the April 22ND date. All leaves must be on the road berm no later than April 21ST

Fall leaf collections will begin October 23rd and continue until the final date of December 18th or first major snowfall. The machines cannot suck up frozen piles of leaves.

No collections after the December 18TH date. All leaves must be on the road berm no later than December 17th

Do not mix branches, limbs and garbage with the leaves. DO NOT place leaves over landscape rocks or other objects that will get sucked into the leaf vac impeller.

Branch Collections for Lake County portion of the community only

Spring branch and limb collections will begin on April 29th and continue until the final date of May 6th for the Lake County portion of the community. Piles must be placed out on or before May 5th but no sooner than 7 days prior to April 29th.

NO COLLECTIONS AFTER THE MAY 6TH DATE!

Fall branch collections will begin on September 9th and continue until the final date of September 16th for the Lake County portion of the community. Piles must be placed out on or before September 15th date but no sooner than 7 days prior to September 9th.

NO COLLECTIONS AFTER THE SEPTEMBER 16TH DATE!

There will be no more collections once the crew has serviced your property.

Branch Collections for Porter County portion of the community only

Spring branch collections will begin on May 13th and continue until the final date of May 20th for the Porter County portion of the community including all of Brandywine, Beachview Ct., Sandy Beach Dr. & all of Forest Ln. Piles must be placed out on or before May 19th but no sooner than 7 days prior to May 13th.

NO COLLECTIONS AFTER THE MAY 20TH DATE!

Fall branch collections will begin on September 23rd and continue until the final date of September 30th for the Porter County portion of the community including Beachview Ct., Sandy Beach Dr. & all of Forest Ln. Piles must be placed out on or before September 29th but no sooner than 7 days prior to September 23rd.

NO COLLECTIONS AFTER THE September 30TH DATE!

There will be no more collections once the crew has serviced your property.

Nothing larger than twelve (12) inches in diameter will be collected.

Do not mix rubbish, roots, dirt and yard waste with branches

No drop offs will be allowed

We will collect branches that have fallen due to storm damage. Please contact the Operations department so they can schedule a collection.

The Operations Department is not only responsible for the collecting of leaves and branches but also responsible for the mowing, trimming and maintenance of the roads, lakes, playground equipment, beach shelters, baseball fields, parks, beaches, accesses and common areas so you can see we must stay on these schedules to give you great service at a timely fashion. Please help us stay on this schedule by getting your leaves and branches out on or before the scheduled dates.
