**RESOLUTION NO. 2011-2-14**

**WHEREAS**, Lakes of the Four Seasons Property Owners' Association, Inc.'s Board of Directors has the authority to establish rules and regulations for the association as set forth in the Lakes of the Four Seasons Property Owners' Association, Inc.'s, Restrictive Covenants; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors:

Finds it necessary from time to time to adopt policies and definitions as it deems necessary to enforce the various Covenants, Articles and By-Laws of the Lakes of the Four Seasons Property Owners' Association, Inc.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Lakes of the Four Seasons Property Owners' Association, Inc., that:

1. Electronically powered craft are allowed on Lake on the Green; provided, however, that Lake on the Green is a "no wake" lake.
2. The Electronically powered craft must fall under the following parameters:
  - a. Can have no more than One (1), Twenty- Four (24) volt power supply system.
  - b. Can have no more than Three (3) HP or One Hundred- Twenty (120) pounds of thrust for Pontoons no longer than Twenty- two (22) feet in length.
  - c. Can have no more than One (1) HP or Sixty- Five (65) pounds of thrust for John Boats and Canoes no longer than Eighteen (18) feet in length.

The initial fine for violating this policy falls under all other Covenants/ Bylaws/ Resolutions/ Rules of the POA Fine Structure.

A daily fine of \$50.00 will be assessed for violation of this policy until brought into compliance.
